CLÁR is a targeted investment programme for rural areas that aims to provide funding for small infra-structural projects in areas that experience disadvantage at Schools /Community Facilities

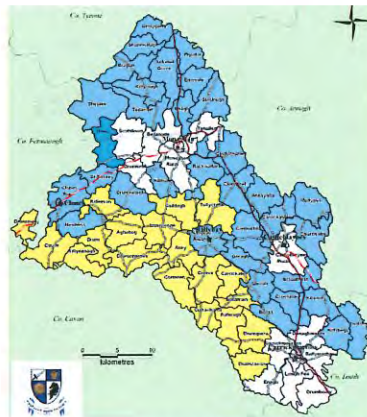
## **Measure 1 Support for Schools/Community Safety Measures**

Up to 90% funding available

### **Eligible Interventions:**

- Amber Safety Lights
- Child Safety Lights
- Speed Safety Lights
- Pedestrian Crossings
- Access footpaths
- Bus Shelters
- Car Parking Facilities
- Public Lighting

Grant Range up to € 50,000



Any DED in yellow or blue is IN a CLAR-eligible area

## **Measure 2 Schools/Community Play Areas**

Up to 90% funding available

Grant Range € 5,000 to € 50,000

## **Measure 3 Targeted Community Infrastructure Needs**

Up to 85% funding available

Grant Range € 5,000 to € 50,000
