15.09 10 May 2020

1. Rory, 2. Drewser, 3. Conor B, 4. Kieran D, 5. Karlo, 6. Bullet (Ryan W for those not in the know!), 7. Micheal B, 8. Darren, 9. Niall, 10. Ryan Mc, 11. Conor Mc, 12. Dessie W, 13. D Malone, 14. Mansy, 15. Chris McG.

15.45 10 May 2020

That's the 15 picked, but let's face it, they'll probably be some changes before the start! 15.46 10 May 2020

Cavan's starting 15 is whoever it is. I don't have a programme.

15.47 10 May 2020

Ok, take that back! Both teams play as selected! Been a while since I heard that at an Ulster Championship match! Also, good to see Tipp beat Waterford and Cork lose to Limerick! Mum will be happy!

15.54 10 May 2020

A Cavan fan is after offering me to rent his programme for €2! I decline!

15.55 10 May 2020

4 minutes from throw in. Monaghan playing into the Town end with a slight breeze in their faces.

15.56 10 May 2020

We have the best National Anthem in the world! Except for Scotland and the French one!

15.58 10 May 2020

And maybe the Italians! 15.59 10 May 2020

And we're off!

16.00 10 May 2020

Very cagey start from both sides. Lots of sideways passing.

16.04 10 May 2020

Karlo fouled, Rory will have a chance from distance but angle isn't great.

16.06 10 May 2020

Dropped short and Cavan clear. They go up the field but record the first wide of the game.

16.07 10 May 2020

Nothing much to report but I'll take it, this time last year we were 5 points down!

16.09 10 May 2020

Opening point from Cavan No 13. Don't know his name but it's probably Reilly! 0-0 v 0-1. Poor wide from Cavan immediately after.

16.11 10 May 2020

Breeze has freshened considerably, has been upgraded to a wind! If it gets much stronger, we might have to name it!

16.14 10 May 2020

2nd point for Cavan, No 8 launches one from a different townland, the wind catches her and she sails over the black spot! 0-0 v 0-2.

16.15 10 May 2020

Finally, Monaghan get on the score board. Nice fielding from Darren, he feeds Dermot who dummies and pops it over. Nice score from the Blayney man. 0-1 v 0-2.

16.28 10 May 2020

Dermot Malone again. Monaghan's best player in the league continues his good form into Championship. 0-5 V 0-3.

16.30 10 May 2020

Sorry, 0-4 v 0-3.

16.31 10 May 2020

Now it's 0-5 v 0-3. Mansy with his first from play following a great piece of high fielding from the ginger lad from Scotstown!

16.33 10 May 2020

3 minutes injury time. Seems about right.

16.35 10 May 2020

PENALTY TO CAVAN!

16.36 10 May 2020

Seemed a bit soft to me. Not as soft as the one last year when Drew barely breathed on yer man, but still soft. Ref has indicated a push but crowd at a loss too. Sean McCaffrey not too happy in the commentary box behind me!

16.37 10 May 2020

GOAL FOR CAVAN. Don't think it was the same taker as last year but he went for the same side, Rory guessed right but in fairness it was right in the corner. 0-5 v 1-3.

16.38 10 May 2020

And that was the last kick of the half. I think Banty will be happy enough after 35 mins. A point down but Monaghan will have a significant wind with them in 2nd half. 0-5 v 1-3. HT

16.39 10 May 2020

Cavan back out on the pitch for about 5 minutes now. Monaghan nowhere to be seen. Ref has started whistling!

16.56 10 May 2020

Just as a linesman is despatched to get the men in white, Ryan Wylie leads his men out for 2nd half.

16.58 10 May 2020

Ok, 2nd half is underway.

17.00 10 May 2020

Harsh yellow on Kieran Duffy. Thought it was a genuine challenge for the ball. Scoreable free for Cavan.

17.02 10 May 2020

Wide.

17.03 10 May 2020

Monaghan punish the wide immediately. Huge kick out from Rory which Ryan Mc runs onto and fires over. Level!

17.04 10 May 2020

Another soft free for Cavan! It's like Joe McQuillan is refereeing this game!

17.06 10 May 2020

Or any game involving Dublin! In other news, Cavan No 10 scores the free. Cavan 1 up!

17.07 10 May 2020

Colin Walshe coming on for Kieran Duffy. Probably because of the yellow.

17.09 10 May 2020

Walshe straight into the fray! Feeds Mickey B who takes off only to be up ended 20 yards out. Tight enough angle. Kieran Hughes shaping up for the free on his left foot.

17.10 10 May 2020

And we're level again! No 17 for Cavan is replacing No 13.

17.10 10 May 2020

Monaghan getting all the breaks in midfield! Darren feeds his midfield partner who is fouled at 55 yards out. Wind has dipped but still should be well within Rory's range.

And it is! He started running back to his goal the minute it left his boot! 1 up. Just over 20 to play.

17.13 10 May 2020

Darren ends 5 minutes of tedious nothing with a whopper from downtown. Crowd stop looking at their phones. 0-9 v 1-4.

17.18 10 May 2020

17.22 10 May 2020

17.24 10 May 2020

BLACK CARD FOR MONAGHAN. Darren pulls what only can be called a "Sean Cavanagh" with a blatant foul just as No 18 was bearing down on the Monaghan goal. It's a black all day long and is in the exact same place where Ryan Wylie was pulled down in first half. Darren departs to a chorus of boos and cheers. Cavan tap over free. 3 up, 9 left plus injury time.

17.26 10 May 2020

This Cavan No 18 can shift, although taking more steps than Rory did in the 2013 semi-final does help. He puts just 2 between them. Monaghan back in a dog fight. Shane Carey has replaced Darren.

17.28 10 May 2020

With Cavan covering all short options, Rory has to go long and Cavan win the ball back but a combination of disciplined defending and an unwillingness to shoot leads to an turnover by Ryan Wylie. Huge fillip for Monaghan. No one looking at their Facebook now! 4 left. Aaron Mulligan for Ryan Mc.

17.33 10 May 2020

17.39 10 May 2020

17.41 10 May 2020
