Clue: I was a member of the Young Ireland movement in the nineteenth century, and later went on to become Prime Minister of the state of Victoria in Australia in 1871. Who am I?



Clue: I was once the National President of the Irish Countrywomen's Association, and also became the first woman elected to Monaghan Urban District Council and later its first woman Chairperson. Who am I?



Clue: I came from Pakistan originally as an asylum seeker, and now I run an award-winning business in Monaghan town. Who am I?



Clue: I once lived at the Castle Leslie estate, and helped Belgian refugees during World War I, bringing them to safety in Monaghan town. Who am I?



Clue: I joined the US Army Air Corps as a combat cameraman, where I took photos during World War II and after the atomic bombs dropped on Hiroshima and Nagasaki. Who am I?



Clue: I am one of the county's most successful sports people, and have won the All-Ireland Ladies Gaelic Football Senior Championship with Monaghan twice! Who am I?
