Statement in Accordance with Section 28(1A)(b) of the Planning and Development (Amendment) Act 2010

The planning authority is required to consider the policies and objectives of the Minister contained in the guidelines when preparing and making the development plan and shall append a statement to the development plan which shall demonstrates:-

- (b) If applicable, that the planning authority has formed the opinion that it is not possible, because of the nature and characteristics of the area of the development plan, to implement certain policies and objectives of the Minister contained in the guidelines when considering the application of those policies in the area of the development plan and shall give reasons for the forming of the opinion and why the policies and objectives of the Minister have not been so implemented

In making the Monaghan County Development Plan 2013-2019 (incorporating the Development Plans for the Towns of Monaghan, Carrickmacross, Castleblayney, Clones and Ballybay) Monaghan Local Authorities took into account the Guidelines issued by the Minister.
