1. RPS Additions – What?

Sept 2015: **756** ministerial recommendations (via NIAH survey of Co MN)...

But, S.55 additions process paused by DAHG...



(4 or more *special interests* - architectural, historical, archaeological, artistic, cultural, scientific, social or technical - as per S.51 of the P&D Act)

1. RPS Additions – What?

16 'Green' Post Boxes 10 Stone Bridges

3 entrance gates 2 houses

2 Sections of the Ulster Canal

2 religious monuments

1 ruinous windmill

1 ruinous country house (Castleshane)

1 canal store (Clones)

1 national school

1 former railway station

... & 2 village water pumps!!!



1. RPS Additions – How?

S.55 process starts with a **6 week observation period...**

- > **Anyone** can comment on the PS proposal.
- Comments must be taken into account by the PA.
- Comments to the contrary must be material, i.e. evidence based.

But, this batch?

2. S.57 Declarations... What?

With Protected Structures, there is **no 'go-ahead' Exempted Development**...

S.57 of the P&D Act: Planning Authority issues a Declaration as to the type of works which it considers would or would not materially affect the character of the structure or any special interest element of the structure.

Request can be **specific** or **general**.

2. S.57 Declarations... How?

Specific (focused/smaller proposal)

> Touch-base with BC or AH first...

General (all aspects of the structure)

- > Request form online & at Planning reception.
- > Timeframe = within 12 weeks.

(1 in 2014, 10 in 2015)

3. BHIS 2016 - What?


Built Heritage Investment Scheme 2016

- > Launched Oct 2015.
- > €2M Nationally > €50k MN.
- > Application closing date: **07/12/15**.

4. ACAs – What?

An Architectural Conservation Area (ACA) is an **area** of special architectural, historic, etc, interest (S.81 of the P&D Act).




