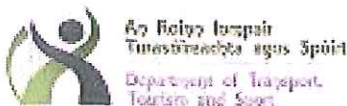

NOTICE OF DRAFT DEVELOPMENT CONTRIBUTION SCHEME 2013-2019

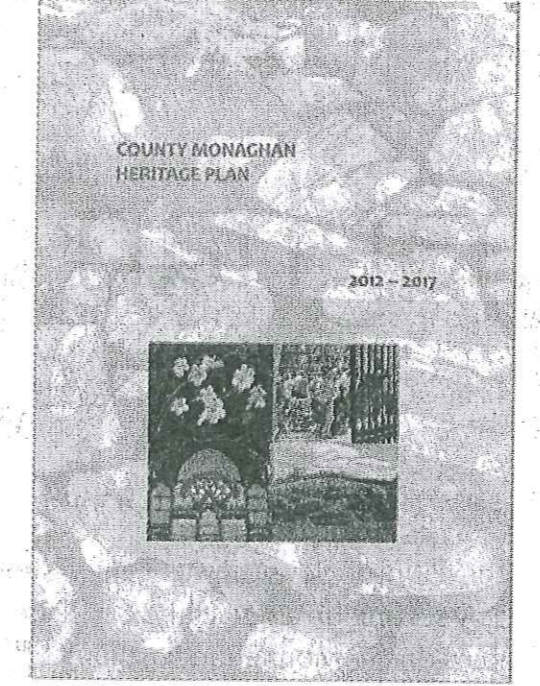

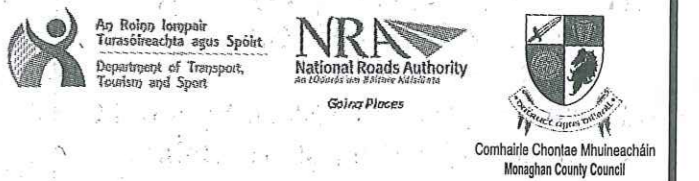
