



ROAD TRAFFIC (SPECIAL SPEED LIMIT BYE-LAWS) (No 2 of 2012)
COUNTY MONAGHAN

MONAGHAN CO. COUNCIL

In exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 46 of the Road Traffic Act, 1961 (No. 24 of 1961), as inserted by section 33 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994 (No. 7 of 1994) and Road Traffic Act 2004, and with the consent of the National Roads Authority, hereby make the following bye – laws in respect of the area comprising the administrative **County of Monaghan**.

Citation

1. These Bye-Laws may be cited as the Road Traffic (Special speed Limits County Monaghan) Bye-Laws, No 2 of 2012

Commencement

2. These Bye – Laws shall come into operation on the 31st December 2012.

Interpretation

3. In these Bye – Laws:

“the act of 1961” means the Road Traffic Act, 1961 (No. 24 of 1961);

“the act of 1993” means the Roads Act, 1993 (No. 14 of 1993);

“the act of 1994” means the Road Traffic Act, 1994 (No. 7 of 1994);

(the act of 2004” means the Road Traffic Act, 2004 (No. 44 of 2004);

“distance” means distance measured along the centre line of the road;

“the Minister” means the Minister for the Environment, Heritage and Local Government;

“motorway” has the meaning assigned to it by the Act of 1993;

“national road” has the meaning assigned to it by the Act of 1993;

“perimeter road” means a road on and along the roadway of which there runs the boundary of a county borough, a borough, or town council or a town and shall be considered as being within such boundary for the purposes of these bye – laws;

“road” means a public road and includes a motorway.

Built up area
Speed Limit

4. (a) Each of the roads described in the First Schedule to these bye-laws is hereby declared not to be a public road in a built-up area for the purposes of section 45 of the Act of 1961 as amended by S. 32 of the Act of 1994 and as amended by the Road Traffic Act of 2004.
- (b) Each of the roads described in the Second Schedule to these bye-laws is hereby declared to be a public road in a built-up area for the purpose of section 45 of the Act of 1961 as amended by S. 32 of the Act of 1994 and as amended by the Road Traffic Act of 2004.

Special Speed
Limit

5. (a) Sixty Kilometres per hour shall be the speed limit for mechanically propelled vehicles on roads specified in the Third Schedule to these bye-laws under the Road Traffic Act 2004, Section 9(9).

Road Works Special
Speed Limit Orders:

6. Under the Road Traffic Act 2004, Section 10, the County Manager, in the interest of Road Safety, can apply a temporary road works speed limit order which will take precedence over any existing Bye-Laws for the duration of the special speed limit.

Exceptions

7. These shall be excepted from the special speed limit prescribed in Article 5 of these regulations and from the built-up area speed limit the following:
 - (a) Ambulances
 - (b) Fire brigade vehicles, and
 - (c) Vehicles used by members of the Garda Siochana in the performance of their duties as such members.

Revocation

8. The Road Traffic (Special Speed Limits)(County Monaghan) Bye-Laws 2012 (April) are hereby revoked.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Roads or sections of road within Town Council boundaries declared not to be public roads in a built-up area for the purposes of section 45 of the Road Traffic Act, 1961.

1. The following road in the town of Ballybay :-

The Monaghan road for a distance of 115 metres from the town boundary.

2. The following roads in the Town council of Carrickmacross :-

- (a) The Shercock road for a distance of 160 metres eastwards from the point where the town council boundary intersects the southern side of the road.
- (b) The Mullinary road where the town council boundary intersects the south side of the road.
- (c) The Lurgans road where the town council boundary intersects the south-west side of the road.
- (d) The Magheross Road (LT 48002) for a distance of 270 metres south from the point where the town council boundary intersects the west side of the road.
- (e) The Kingscourt Road (R-179) for a distance of 530 metres west from the point where the town council boundary intersects the south side of the road.

3. The following road in the Town council of Castleblayney :-

- (a) The Keady Road for a distance of 93 metres from the town council boundary.

4. The following roads in the Town council of Clones :-

- (a) Mullanmoy Lane for a distance of 10 metres from its junction with N54 Cavan Road.
- (b) The Cavan Road (National Road N54) for a distance of 502 metres from the town council boundary.

5. The following roads in the Town council of Monaghan :-

- (a) The Clones Road (National Road N54) for a distance of 691 metres from the point where the town council boundary intersects the northern side of the road.
- (b) The Coolshannagh Road for a distance of 181 metres from the Town Council boundary.
- (c) The Killygowan Road for a distance of 100 metres from its junctions with the Ballybay road.
- (d) The Scotstown Road for a distance of 260 metres from the point where the town council boundary intersects the south-eastern side of the road.
- (e) The Ballybay Road for a distance of 315 metres from the town council boundary.
- (f) The Dunsinare road for a distance of 30 metres from the town council boundary.
- (g) The Killyconnigan Road for a distance of 45 metres from its junction with the Monaghan – Clones Road (National Road N54)
- (h) The Milltown Road for a distance of 364 metres from the town Council boundary.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Roads or section of road outside town council boundaries declared to be public roads in a built-up area for the purposes of section 45 of the Road Traffic Act, 1961.

1. The following roads at Aghabog: -

- (a) The Latnamard Road (LT 24112) between a point 165 metres east from Mulligan's Crossroads (junction with LS06410 & LS06411) to a point 80 metres east of its junction with the Chapel Lane Road (LT 24111).
- (b) The Chapel Lane Road (LT 24111) for a distance of 240 metres north from its junction with the Latnamard Road (LT 24112).

2. The following road at Annyalla: -

- (a) The Keady road from a distance of 65 metres from the Castleblayney – Monaghan (National Road N2) to a distance of 408 metres from the Castleblayney – Monaghan Road.

3. The following roads at Ballinode:-

- (a) The Monaghan-Scotstown Road between a point 395 metres east of its junction with the Lemaculla Road and a point 50 metres west of its junction with the Roslea Road.
- (b) The Roslea Road for a distance of 90 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Scotstown road.
- (c) The Smithborough Road for a distance of 195 metres from its junction with the Roslea Road.
- (d) The Lemaculla Road for a distance of 396 metres north east of its junction with Carrowhatta Road.
- (e) Carrowhatta Lane for a distance of 50 metres from its junction with the Lemaculla Road.

4. The following roads at Ballybay:-

- (a) O'Duffy Terrace.
- (b) The Carrickmacross Road for a distance of 477 metres south-east from its Junction with the Creeve Road.
- (c) The Castleblayney Road for a distance of 460 metres from the point where the boundary of the town of Ballybay intersects the southern side of the road.

- (d) The Clones Road for a distance of 190 metres from the boundary of the town of Ballybay.
- (e) The Cootehill Road for a distance of 145 metres from its junction with the Carrickmacross Road.
- (f) The Creeve Road for a distance of 70 metres south east of its junction with the Carrickmacross Road.

5. The following roads adjacent to the Town council of Carrickmacross :-

- (a) Drummond Heights.
- (b) The Old N2 Castleblayney Road (Regional Road R-927) for a distance of 290 metres from the boundary of the town council of Carrickmacross.
- (c) The Ballybay Road for a distance of 900 metres from its junction with the Old N2 Castleblayney Road (Regional Road R-927).
- (d) The Old N2 Ardee Road (Local Road LP-04921) from the junction with Regional Road R-927 to a point 263 metres south of the said junction from the point where the boundary of the town council of Carrickmacross intersects the western side of the road.
- (e) The Crossmaglen Road for a distance of 555 metres from the point where the boundary of the town council of Carrickmacross intersects the northern side of the road.
- (f) The Dundalk Road for a distance of 190 metres south east from the boundary of the town council of Carrickmacross.
- (g) The Lisanisk Road for a distance of 20 metres from the junction with the Crossmaglen R178 road.
- (h) The N2 R180 Link Road from the R180 junction to a distance 20 metres from the roundabout.
- (i) The LS08150 Lisgall Road (Old Castleblayney Road) for a distance of 20 metres from its junction with the N2 R180 Link Road.
- (j) The Regional Road R-927 from the point where the town council boundary of the town council of Carrickmacross intersects the western side of the road to a point 20 metres west of the junction with the Dundalk Road (R-178) roundabout.

6. The following roads at Carrickroe :-

- (a) The Deravoy Road between points 475 metres south east from its junction with the Drumbriston Road and 250 metres west from its junction with the Drumbriston Road.
- (b) The Drumbriston Road from its junction with the Deravoy Road for a distance 260 metres north.
- (c) The Derryveagh Road from its junction with the Drumbriston Road for a distance 89 metres north east.
- (d) The Derryhellan Road from its junction with the Deravoy Road to a point 25m south of the said junction.

7. The following roads adjacent to the Town council of Castleblayney :-

- (a) The Monaghan Road (National Road N2) for a distance of 519 metres north west of its junction with the Drumillard housing estate entrance.
- (b) The Carrickmacross Road (National Road N2) for a distance of 424 metres south east of its junction with the Dundalk Road (National Road N53).
- (c) The Dundalk Road (National Road N53) for a distance of 356 metres from its junction with the Carrickmacross Road (National Road N2).
- (d) The Shercock Road (Regional Road R181) for a distance of 460 metres south west of its junction with the Second Bree Road (County Road LS 07850)
- (e) The Kinnagin Road (County Road LP03810) for a distance of 35 metres south east of its junction with the Shercock Road (Regional Road R181).
- (f) The Mile Hill Road for a distance of 105 metres west from its junction with the Shercock road.
- (g) The Knockavolis Road (County Road LS7800) 60 metres south of its junction with the second Bree Road (County Road LS 7850).

8. The following roads adjacent to the Town council of Clones :-

- (a) The Scotshouse Road for a distance of 600 metres from the point where the Town council boundary intersects the western edge of the road.
- (b) The Newtownbutler Road for a distance of 125 metres from the boundary of the town council of Clones.

- (c) The Roslea Road to a point 35 metres south west from its junction with the Tirnahinch Far Road.
- (d) The Newbliss Road for a distance of 340 metres from the point where the Town council boundary intersects the southern edge of the road.
- (e) The Lackey Road for a distance of 565 metres from the point where the town Council boundary intersects the north east edge of the road.
- (f) The Magheraveely Road for a distance of 5 metres from the point where the Town council boundary intersects the north east edge of the road.
- (g) The Monaghan Road (National Road N54) from the Town Council Boundary to a point 765m (340 m) east of its junction with O' Duffy Street.

9. The following roads at Clontibret :-

- (a) The Tullybuck road between a point at its junction with the old Monaghan-Castleblayney road and a point 825 metres east of said junction.
- (b) The old Monaghan-Castleblayney Road between a point at the junction with the N2 road and a point 196 metres south-east of its junction with the Keady Road.
- (c) The Carrickaderry Road for a distance of 503 metres north east from its junction with the old Monaghan-Castleblayney Road.
- (d) The Ballybay Road (R184) for a distance of 27 metres south west from its junction with the old Monaghan-Castleblayney Road.
- (e) The Keady Road for a distance of 625 metres north east from its junction with the old Monaghan-Castleblayney Road.
- (f) The Fintully Road (LS 07522) for a distance of 475 metres north east from its junction with the Keady Road.

10. The following roads at Corcaghan :-

- (a) The Cavanagarvan Road for a distance of 61 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Rockcorry Road.
- (b) The Corcaghan Road for a distance of 239 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Rockcorry Road.
- (c) The Monaghan-Rockcorry Road between a point 136 metres south from the junction of the Cavanagarvan and a point 245 metres north of the junction with the Corcaghan Road.

11. The following road at Corduff: -

The Corduff Road (LP 04031) between a point 226 metres south east of its junction with the Ouvry Road (LS 08011) and 121 metres south east of its junction with the Shanco road (LT 40202).

12. The following road at Corracrin: -

The Dublin-Derry Road (National Road N2) between a point 54 metres north of its junction with the Mullaghpeak Road and a point 38 metres south of its junction with the Derryhallagh junction.

13. The following road at Cremartin: -

- (a) The Scotch Corner-Castleblayney Road (LP03411) between a point 120 metres north west of its junction with the Cloghan Road (LP03400) and a point 120 metres southeast of the said junction.
- (b) The Cloghan Road (LP03400) for a distance of 295 metres east from its junction with the Scotch Corner – Castleblayney Road (LP03411)

14. The following roads at Donaghmoynne :-

- (a) The LP4510 west from the junction with LT45102 for 232 metres.
- (b) The LT4510 north from the junction with the LT45102 for 329 metres.
- (c) The LT45102 south from junction with LP4510 for 258 metres.
- (d) The LT45101 east from junction with LT45102 for 235 metres.

15. The following roads at Doohamlet :-

- (a) The Ballybay-Castleblayney Road between a point 770 metres west of its junction with the Clonaneor Road and a point 90 metres east of the said junction.
- (b) The Clonaneor Road for a distance of 220 metres from its junction with the Ballybay-Castleblayney Road.
- (c) The Rossollus Road for a distance of 45 metres from its junction with the Ballybay-Castleblayney Road.

16. The following roads at Drum :-

- (a) The Clones-Cootehill Road between a point 686 metres north-west of its junction with the Rockcorry Road and a point 265 metres south-east of the said junction.
- (b) The Newbliss Road for a distance of 274 metres from its junction with the Clones-Cootehill Road.
- (c) The Rockcorry Road for a distance of 550 metres from its junction with the Clones-Cootehill Road.
- (d) The road connecting the Rockcorry Road with the Newbliss Road.
- (e) The Violet Brae Road for a distance of 65 metres from its junction with the Clones-Cootehill Road.

17. The following roads in Emyvale :-

- (a) The Dublin-Derry Road (National Road N2) between a point 268 metres south of its junction with the Glaslough Road and a point 244 metres north-west of its junction with the Mullan Road.
- (b) The Glaslough Road for a distance of 311 metres from its junction with the Dublin-Derry Road (National Road N2).
- (c) The Mullan Road for a distance of 97 metres north east of junction with Derrygasson Lower Road.
- (d) The McCready Mill Road for a distance of 520 metres west from its junction with the Dublin-Derry Road (National Road N2).
- (e) Market House Lane Road for a distance of 427 metres from its junction with the Dublin-Derry Road (National Road N2).
- (f) The Derrygasson Lower Road for a distance of 56 metres south-east with junction of Mullen Road.
- (g) The Mullan-Figanny Road (LP 01202) between a point 165 metres north east of its junction with the Cavan - Killyrean Upper Road (LS 05202 & LS05203) and a point 702 metres north east of said junction.

18. The following roads at Glaslough :-

- (a) Main Street for a distance of 419 metres south of its junction with the Glaslough-Emyvale Road.

- (b) The Glaslough-Emyvale Road for a distance of 62 metres west of its junction with the Caledon Road.
- (c) The Caledon Road for a distance of 406 metres from its junction with the Glaslough-Emyvale Road.

19. The following roads at Inniskeen :-

- (a) On the LP4622 from a point 360 metres west of the junction with the LS8602 through the village on the LP4623 to a point 940 metres east of the junction with the LP4630.
- (b) On the LP4630 for a distance of 717 metres from the junction with the LP4622

20. The following roads at Knockatallon:

- (a) The Knockacullion road for a distance of 42 metres south east from its junction with the Knockatallon Road.
- (b) The Knockatallon road between a point 316 metres north east from its junction with the Knockacullion road and a point 267 south west of the said junction with Knockacullion Road.

21. The following roads at Latton:

- (a) The Moylemore-Lisdrumcleve Road (LP03012) for a distance of 230 metres east of its junction with the Lisdrumcleve – Drumcanon Road (LT30122).
- (b) The Moylemore-Lisdrumcleve Road (LP03012) for a distance of 290 metres North from its junction with the Lisdrumcleve – MountainLodge Road (LS0700).
- (c) The Lisdrumcleve – Drumcanon Road (LT30122) for a distance of 40 metres south from its junction with the Moylemore-Lisdrumcleve Road (LP03012).
- (d) The Lisdrumcleve – MountainLodge Road (LS0700) for a distance of 200 metres west from its junction with the Moylemore-Lisdrumcleve Road (LP03012).

22. The following roads at Lisdoonan:

- (a) The Lisdoonan-Crossalare Road (LP 04103) for a distance of 165 metres north from its junction with the Drumberagh Road (LS 08180).

- (b) The Lisdoonan Road (LP 04102) from its junction with the Drumberagh Road (LS 08180) to a point 430 metres south east of its junction with the Corleck Road (LP 08160).
- (c) The Drumberagh Road (LS 08180) for a distance of 70 metres west from its junction with the Drumberagh Road (LS 08180).
- (e) The Corleck Road (LP 08160) for a distance of 528 metres south east from its junction with the Lisdoonan Road (LS 04102).

23. The following roads at Lurgans:

The LS8900 Lurgans for a distance of 785 meters from a point where the boundary of the town Council of Carrickmacross intersects the southern side of the road.

24. The following roads at Magherarny:

- (a) The Smithboro – Killeevan road from its junction with the N54 to a point 5 metres north of its junction with local road LS 06160.
- (b) The Railway Bridge road from a point 70 metres south east of its junction with the N54 to its junction with the Smithboro - Killeevan road.

25. The following roads adjacent to the Town Council of Monaghan:

- (a) The Castleblayney Road (R937) (*Old National Road N2*) from the town council boundary to a point 223 metres south-east of said boundary i.e. to the yield line on the Southern Roundabout of the Monaghan Town By-Pass (National Road N2).
- (b) The Cootehill Road from the town council boundary to a point 322 metres south of its junction with the SheeTrim Road.
- (c) Aghananimy Road (Graveyard Road) for a distance of 172 metres south of the Town council Boundary.
- (d) The Old Armagh Road for a distance of 180 metres from the point where the town council boundary intersects the south-eastern side of the road.
- (e) The Tullyhirm Road (North) for a distance of 246 metres south-west from its junction with the Armagh Road (National Road N12).
- (f) The Tullyhirm Road (South) for a distance of 291 metres north-east from the town council boundary.

- (g) The Emyvale Road (National Road N2) from the town council boundary to a point 376 metres north-west of said boundary.
- (h) The Monaghan Town By-Pass (National Road N2) between the point where the town council boundary intersects the Emyvale Road (National Road N2) entry onto the Northern Roundabout of Monaghan Town By-Pass and a point 80 metres south-east of the yield line on said roundabout.
- (i) The Monaghan Town By-Pass (National Road N2) between a point 70m north of the yield line on the Southern Roundabout of the Monaghan Town By-Pass and a point 667 metres south-east of the yield line on said roundabout, along the N2 Dublin-Derry Road.
- (j) The Armagh Road (National Road N12) between the yield line on the Northern Roundabout of the Monaghan Town By-Pass (National Road N2) and a point 145 metres north-east of the yield line on said roundabout.
- (k) The Sheetrim Road from its junction with the Cootehill Road to a point 100 metres south from its junction with the Cootehill Road.

26. The following roads at Milltown :-

- (a) The Blackwater Vale Road for a distance of 190 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Milltown Road.
- (b) The Telaydan Road for a distance of 64 metres from its junction with the Blackwater Vale Road.
- (c) The Gallanagh Road for a distance of 360 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Milltown Road.
- (d) The Milltown Road from a point where the urban boundary intersects the southern side of the road to a point 502 metres north west of the junction with the Blackwater Vale Road.

27. The following roads at Newbliss :-

- (a) The Monaghan-Drum Road between a point 575 metres north-east of its junction with the Ballybay Road and a point 420 metres south-east of its junction with the Hazel Brae Road.
- (b) The Killeevan Road for a distance of 325 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Drum Road.
- (c) The Ballybay Road for a distance of 335 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Drum Road.

- (d) The Scotshouse Road for a distance of 304 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Drum Road.
- (e) The Hazel Brae Road for a distance of 5 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Drum Road.

28. The following roads at Oram :-

- (a) The Oram-Castleblayney road (Regional Road R182) between a point 235 metres north-east of its junction with the Lurganmore road (County Road LT 76002) and a point 620 metres south-west of the said junction.
- (b) The Lurganmore road (County Road LT 76002) for a distance of 505 metres west of its junction with the Oram-Castleblayney road (Regional Road R182).

29. The following roads at Rockcorry :-

- (a) The Monaghan-Cootehill Road between a point 643 metres north-east of its junction with the Newbliss Road and a point 455 metres south-west of its junction with the Ballybay Road.
- (b) The Newbliss Road for a distance of 106 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Cootehill Road.
- (c) The Ballybay Road for a distance of 447 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Cootehill Road.
- (d) The Old Road for a distance of 350 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Cootehill Road.
- (e) The Corkeeran Road for a distance of 80 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Cootehill Road.

30. The following roads at Scotch Corner :-

- (a) The Scotch Corner – Clontibret Road (R184-1) for a distance of 178 metres north east from its junction with the old Monaghan – Castleblayney Road (LP03300/LP03421).
- (b) The Scotch Corner – Tullycorbet Road (R184-2) for a distance of 135 metres south west from its junction with the old Monaghan – Castleblayney Road (LP3300/LP03421).
- (c) The Scotch Corner – Monaghan Road (LP03300) for a distance of 142 metres north west from its junction with the Scotch Corner – Tullycorbet Road (R184-2).

- (d) The Scotch Corner – Castleblayney Road (LP03421) for a distance of 131 metres south east from its junction with the Scotch Corner – Tullycorbet Road (R184-2)

31. The following roads at Scotshouse :-

- (a) The Clones-Ballyhaise Road between a point 393 metres north-east of its junction with the Belturbet Road and a point 360 metres of the said junction.
- (b) The Belturbet Road for a distance of 81 metres from its junction with the Clones-Ballyhaise Road.
- (c) The Creamery Road for a distance of 300 metres from its junction with the Clones-Ballyhaise Road.
- (d) The Drum Road for a distance of 50 metres from its junction with the Clones-Ballyhaise Road.

32. The following roads at Scotstown :-

- (a) The Monaghan-Knockatallon Road between a point 465 metres south-east of its junction with the Tydavnet Road and a point 250 metres north-west of the said junction.
- (b) The Tydavnet Road for a distance of 115 metres northeast from its junction with the Stracunnion Road (LT20002).
- (c) The Smithborough Road for a distance of 308 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Knockatallon Road.
- (d) The Gola Road for a distance of 374 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Knockatallon Road.
- (e) Carrowhatta Lane (LT20001) for a distance of 50 metres from its junction with the Tydavnet Road.

33. The following roads at Smithborough :-

- (a) The Monaghan-Clones Road (National Road N54) between a point 279 metres north east of its junction with the Roslea Road and a point 535 metres south west of the said junction.
- (b) The Roslea Road for a distance of 156 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Clones Road (National Road N54).

34. The following roads at Threemilehouse :-

- (a) The Monaghan-Newbliss road between a point 465 metres east of its junction with the Corcaghan Road and a point 470 metres south-west of the said junction.
- (b) The Corcaghan Road for a distance of 218 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Newbliss Road.
- (c) The Church Road for a distance of 225 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Newbliss Road.
- (d) The Drumguill Road for a distance of 15 metres from its junction with the Church Road.
- (e) The Drumsnatt road for a distance of 60 metres northwest of its junction with the Monaghan – Newbliss road.
- (f) The LT-21804 road for a distance of 5 metres northwest of its junction with the Monaghan-Newbliss Road.

35. The following roads at Tydavnet :-

- (a) The Monaghan-Clogher road between a point 160 metres south-west of its junction with the Scotstown Road and a point 269 metres north-east of its junction with the Emyvale Road.
- (b) The Scotstown Road for a distance of 230 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Clogher Road.
- (c) The Emyvale Road for a distance of 80 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Clogher Road.
- (d) The Monaghan (Back) Road (LS 5190) for a distance of 115 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Clogher Road (R186).

THIRD SCHEDULE

Road in respect of which a special speed limit of 60 kph is prescribed.

1. The following roads at Annyalla :-

- (a) The Monaghan-Castleblayney Road (National Road N2) between a point 290 metres north-west of its junction with the Cremartin Road and a point 352 metres south-east of the said junction.
- (b) The Cremartin Road for a distance of 90 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Castleblayney Road (National Road N2).
- (c) The Keady Road for a distance of 65 metres from its junction with the Monaghan-Castleblayney Road (National Road N2).

2. The following road at Ballinode :-

- (a) The Monaghan-Scotstown Road between a point 395 metres east of its junction with the Lemaculla Road and a point 75 metres distance from the Monaghan-Tydavnet Road.

3. The following roads in and adjacent to the Town council of Carrickmacross :-

- (a) The Shercock road between a point 160 metres east of the point where the boundary of the town council of Carrickmacross intersects the southern side of the road and a point 360 metres north-west of the said intersection.
- (b) The Old N2 Castleblayney road (Regional Road R-927) from a point 290 metres north of the boundary of the town council of Carrickmacross to
 - a point 20 metres from the roundabout on the Northwest ramp of the Carrickmacross ByPass Northern Interchange;
 - a point 20 metres from the roundabout on the southeast ramp of the Carrickmacross ByPass Northern Interchange;
 - a point 20 metres from the roundabout of the Carrickmacross ByPass Northern Interchange on the N2 R180 Link Road.
- (c) The Ballybay road between a point 900 metres north-west of its junction with the Old N2 Castleblayney Road (Regional Road R-927)) and a point 1478 metres north-west of the said junction.
- (d) The Drumcondra Road for a distance of 989 metres from its junction with the Old N2 Ardee Road (Local Road LP-04921).

- (e) The Dundalk Road between a point 190 metres south-east of the boundary of the town council of Carrickmacross and a point 1597 metres south-east of the said boundary.
- (f) The Killanny Road for a distance of 55 metres from its junction with the Dundalk Road.
- (g) The Old N2 Ardee Road (LP-04921) between a point 263 metres south of its junction with the Regional Road R-927, and a point 854 metres south of the said junction.
- (h) The LS08150 Lisgall Road (Old Castleblayney Road) for a distance of 87 metres from its junction with the N2 R180 Link Road.
- (i) The Mullinary road from the town council boundary to the R178.
- (j) The Derryolam/Tiragarvan Road LP4000 road 20 metres from the junction of the R178.

4. **The following roads in and adjacent to the Town council of Castleblayney**

- (a) The Carrickmacross Road (National Road N2) between a point 424 metres south east of its junction with the Dundalk Road (National Road N53) and a point 704 metres south east of the said junction.
- (b) The Monaghan road (National road N2) between a point 519 metres north-west of its junction with the Drumillard housing Estate entrance and a point 56 metres north-west of its junction with the Ballybay road.
- (c) The Dundalk Road (National road N53) between a point 356 metres east of its junction with the Carrickmacross Road (National road N2) and a point 1008 metres south-east of the said junction.
- (d) The Ballybay Road for a distance of 105 metres from its junction with the Monaghan Road (National road N2).

5. **The following roads in and adjacent to the Town council of Clones :-**

- (a) The Newtownbutler Road between a point 125 metres south-west of the boundary of the town council of Clones and a point 339 metres south-west of the said boundary.
- (b) The Monaghan Road (National Road N54) from a point 965m north-east of its junction with O' Duffy Street to a point 765m north-east of said junction.

6. **The following roads at Cootehill :-**

- (a) The Monaghan Road (R188) for a distance 200 metres north of the New Bridge (County Cavan Border).

7. **The following roads at Corracrin :-**

- (a) The Dublin-Derry Road (N2) for a distance of 67 metres North with junction of the Two Trees Road.
- (b) The Dublin-Derry Road (N2) for a distance of 135 metres South of Junction with the Mullaghpeak Road.
- (c) The Mullaghpeak Road for a distance of 50 metres East of the junction with the Dublin-Derry Road.(N2)
- (d) The Two Trees road for a distance of 55 metres West of the junction with the Dublin-Derry Road (N2)
- (e) The Derryhallagh Road for a distance of 50 metres North-East of the junction with the Dublin-Derry Road (N2)

8. **The following road at Doohamlet :-**

- (a) The Ballybay-Castleblayney Road between a point 90 metres east of its junction with the Clonaneor Road and a point 700 metres east of the said junction.

9. **The following road at Emyvale :-**

- (a) The National Primary (N2) for a distance of 697 metres North of junction with Mullan Road.

10. **The following roads at Inniskeen :-**

- (a) On the LP4621 from a point 20 metres west of the junction with the LS8620 to a point on the LP4621 360 metres west of the junction with the LS8602.

11. **The following roads at Lough Egish :-**

- (a) The Ballybay-Carrickmacross Road R180 between a point 100 metres north west of it's junction with the Castleblayney-Shercock Road R181 and a point 550 metres south-east of the said junction.
- (b) The Castleblayney-Shercock Road R181 between a point 100 metres north of its junction with the Ballybay-Carrickmacross Road R180 and a point 1,000 metres south of the said junction.

12. The following roads in and adjacent to the Town Council of Monaghan :-

- (a) The Armagh Road (National Road N12) between a point 145 metres north-east of the Northern Roundabout of the Monaghan Town By-Pass (National Road N2) and a point 803 metres north-east of said roundabout.
- (b) The Ballybay Road between a point 315 metres north-west of the boundary of the town council of Monaghan and a point 80 metres south-east of the said boundary.
- (c) The Clones Road (National Road N54) between a point 691 metres north-east of the point where the boundary of the town council of Monaghan intersects the northern side of the road and a point 415 metres west of the said intersection.
- (d) The Newbliss Road between its junction with the Clones Road (National Road N54) and a point 175 metres South-west of the point where the boundary of the town council of Monaghan intersects the south-eastern side of the road.
- (e) The Scotstown Road between a point 260 metres east of the point where the boundary of the town council of Monaghan intersects the southern side of the road and a point 187 metres north-west of the said intersection.
- (f) The Killyconnigan road for a distance of 45 metres from its junction with the Monaghan – Clones Road. (N54).
- (g) The Killygoan road for a distance of 100 metres from the Ballybay Road junction to the Ballybay road.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the instrument and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).

These Bye-Laws replace the Road Traffic (Speed Limits) (County of Monaghan) Bye Laws (No 1 of 2012) and alter the speed limits applicable to certain roads in this area.

The Bye-Laws exclude the public roads mentioned in the First Schedule from the scope of the built-up area speed limit prescribed by section 45 of the Road Traffic Act, 1961 as amended by S. 32 of the Act of 1994, and declare the public roads mentioned in the Second Schedule to be subject to that speed limit.

The Bye-Laws also prescribe a speed limit of 60 kilometres per hour in respect of the public roads mentioned in the Third Schedule.

Ambulances, Fire Brigade vehicles and Garda Síochána vehicles being used in the course of duty are exempted from all speed limits by the Regulations.
