



MONAGHAN COUNTY COUNCIL DRAFT ROAD TRAFFIC (SPECIAL SPEED LIMITS) (NATIONAL ROADS) COUNTY OF MONAGHAN BYE-LAWS (NO.1) 2019

Monaghan County Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Act (No. 44) of 2004 as amended, has prepared the above named Draft Bye-Laws. The purpose of these Bye-Laws is to introduce special speed limits on designated sections of National Roads throughout County Monaghan.
