# What's Proposed?

- Trial Shuttle System over Fane River
   Bridge from October 2<sup>nd</sup> to 30th
- Temporary Traffic Signals to control traffic over the bridge to one way flow
- Installation of temporary shared path over the bridge along the eastern parapet.
- Signalised pedestrian crossing on the L4630 at the Church.
- Courtesy shuttle system under the railway bridge on L4630.
- Enhanced safety for pedestrians and cyclists wishing to cross the bridge.
- · Improved road safety for road users.
- Provide a sustainable transport alternative for the workers and nearby creche and primary school students.
- Improve access to the town centre and for commuting journeys.
- Data will be collected during the trial to assess feasibility and operability of a Shuttle System over Fane River Bridge.

# **Things to Know**

- Two week trial period (from 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2025 to 30<sup>th</sup> October
- One Way Traffic Flow over Fane River Bridge
- Courtesy give way system through rail bridge underpass
- Temporary shared path provided over Fane River Bridge.

# Why is this change proposed?

The existing path over the Fane River Bridge is narrow and does not safely allow pedestrians and cyclists to cross Fane River. Below are some of the anticipated benefits from these changes:

#### **Local Benefits**

- Similar schemes in Co. Kildare such as
   Kildangan Bridge shuttle system have
   managed traffic on an existing narrow bridge,
   providing space for active travel, helping make
   area safer and more attractive for active travel.
- Safer walking and cycling facilities help more people to choose to walking or cycling for short trips.
- Safer facilities will encourage more children to walk or cycle to nearby St Daigh's National School.
- Proposed shared path will segregate vulnerable road users from vehicular traffic.
- Enhanced accessibility and safety with minimum delays.
- Provides a link across the bridge and connects to the Monaghan Way, enhancing pedestrian and recreational access in the area.
