



**Screening Determination for Strategic Environmental Assessment under
SEA Directive 2001/42/EC**

Planning and Development (Strategic Environmental Assessment) Regulations 2004 (SI No. 436 of 2004), as amended by the Planning and Development (Strategic Environmental Assessment) (Amendment) Regulations 2011 (SI No. 201 of 2011)

For:

Clones Urban Mobility Plan (Monaghan County Council).

This SEA Screening Determination has been made having regard to the requirements of Directive 2001/42/EC on the assessment of the effects of certain plans and programmes on the environment, the European Communities (Environmental Assessment of Certain Plans and Programmes) Regulations 2004 (S.I. No. 435 of 2004), as amended, and the Planning and Development (Strategic Environmental Assessment) Regulations 2011 (S.I. No. 201 of 2011, as amended).

Screening for Strategic Environmental Assessment has been carried out by Monaghan County Council in accordance with Articles 3(3) and 3(4) of the SEA Directive and Schedule 2A of the SEA Regulations. The determination is informed by the SEA Screening Report prepared by Flynn Furney Environmental Consultants

Following assessment of the criteria and having regard to the nature of the Clones Urban Mobility Plan and the potential for likely significant environmental effects from implementation of the Urban Mobility Plan, MCC has determined that the Urban Mobility Plan will not give rise to likely significant effects on the environment.

It is therefore determined that Strategic Environmental Assessment is not required for the Clones Urban Mobility Plan.

In accordance with Article 9(7) of S.I. 435 of 2004, as amended, Monaghan County Council will notify the SEA environmental authorities of its determination that SEA is not required and place a copy of said determination on public display together with the present report and associated documentation relating to the Urban Mobility Plan for Clones Town.
