The Creative Ireland Programme

CLÁR ÉIRE ILDÁNACH

The Creative Ireland Programme is the Government's Legacy Programme for Ireland 2016 – a five-year initiative, from 2017 to 2022, which places creativity at the centre of public policy. It is a high-level, high-ambition, all-of-government initiative to mainstream creativity in the life of the nation so that individually and collectively, in our personal lives and in our institutions, we can realise our full creative potential.

The Creative Ireland Programme is a culture-based programme designed to promote individual, community and national wellbeing. The core proposition is that participation in cultural activity drives personal and collective creativity, with significant implications for individual and societal wellbeing and achievement.

The Creative Ireland Programme is also the main implementation vehicle for the priorities identified in the Government's policy document, Culture 2025 – Éire Ildánach, which states that arts and culture are intrinsic to the Irish State, acknowledges the need to increase access to and participation in the arts, boost our creative industries, and preserve our heritage with a particular focus on language, landscape and the environment.

The programme is built around the themes of identity, culture and citizenship. The core operating principles are Collaboration and Communication, Community Empowerment, and Internationalisation.

Is ionann Clár Éire Ildánach agus Clár Iarmhartach an Rialtais a d'eascair as Éire 2016 - tionscnamh cúig bliana, ó 2017 go 2022, a bhfuil sé mar aidhm leis an chruthaitheacht a chur i gcroílár an pholasáí phoiblí. Is tionscnamh ardleibhéil uaillmhianach uile-Rialtais é chun an chruthaitheacht a phríomhshruthú i saol na hÉireann ionas go mbeidh muid in ann ár gcumas cruthaitheach iomlán a bhaint amach go haonair agus le cheile, inár saoil phearsanta agus inár n-institiúidí.

Tionscnamh atá i gClár Éire Ildánach atá bunaithe ar an gcultúr agus atá leagtha amach le folláine an duine aonair, an phobail agus an náisiúin a chur chun cinn. Is é an bunsmaoineamh go mbíonn rannpháirtíocht i gngíomhaíochtaí cultúir ina shiochair leis an gcruthaitheacht phearsanta agus le cruthaitheacht an chomhair agus go dtagann tortháí suntasacha dá bharr sin maidir le folláine an duine agus an phobail agus lena gcuireann an duine agus an pobal i gcrích.

Ina theannta sin, is é Clár Éire Ildánach an príomhchóras trína gcuirfear i bhfeidhm na tosaíochtaí a leagtar amach i ndoiciméad polasaí an Rialtais dar teideal Cultúr 2025/Éire Ildánach, ina luitear gur gné bhunúsach de Stát na hÉireann na healaíona agus an cultúr agus ina n-adhmaítear gur gá teacht a bheith níos furasta ar ghnéithe de na healaíona, rannpháirtíocht sna healaíona a bheith níos coitianta, borradh a chur faoi thionscail na cruthaitheachta agus an oidhreacht a chaomhnú, le béim faoi leith ar an teanga, ar an tírdhreach agus ar an timpeallacht.

Tá an clár bunaithe ar théamaí an aitheantaí, an chultúir agus na saoránachta. Is iad na prionsabail lárnacha oibriúcháin atá ann ná an Comhar agus an Chumarsáid, Cumású an Phobail, agus Idirnáisiúnú.

Local authorities have a crucial role in the overall local delivery of the entire Creative Ireland programme and are exclusively mandated, through their culture teams, to deliver Pillar 2 of the programme – Enabling Creativity in Every Community. This devolution of responsibility for Creative Ireland to local authorities is inspired by the extraordinary impact of collaborative local authority co-ordinated projects for the centenary of 1916.

This Plan sets out the beginning of our part in this five-year journey, a truly important national policy initiative centred on culture and wellbeing. Monaghan is a county historically steeped in cultural heritage and industry. It is renowned for its cultural and creative activity, with a wealth of vibrant heritage, arts and culture opportunities for everyone to learn and engage with.

The establishment in recent years of the Heritage Network and Arts Network has enabled and developed more community awareness and engagement in arts, culture and heritage. Both have identified hidden gems of cultural activity whilst discovering a wealth of talented people across the county, who were quietly working away unbeknown to the wider community. The Arts Network monthly showcase event, has been a tremendous success in showcasing and bringing to the fore the vast range of creative people living in our community from songwriters, poets, artists, local historians to digital media/technology.

Tá ról thar a bheith tábhachtach ag údarás áitiúla i dtaca le Clár Éire Ildánach, ina ionmláine, a chur i gcrích agus tá sainordú eisiach acu, trína gcuid meitheacha cultúir, Colún 2 den chlár a chur i gcrích - Bonn a chur faoin gCruthaitheacht i ngach Pobal. Tá cineachadh na freaghracha i leith an Chláir seo chuig na húdarás áitiúla bunaithe ar thionchar urghnách na dtionscadal comhoibrófach a chomhordaigh údarás áitiúla do chothrom céad bliain 1916.

Sa Phlean seo, leagtar amach túis ár róil sa turas cúig bliana seo, ar tionscnamh fiorthábhachtach polasaí náisiúnta é atá diríthe ar chultúr agus ar fholáiné. Go stairiúil, is contae é Muineachán atá ar maos san oidhreacht chultúrtha agus i dtionsclaíocht. Tá cál air as a ghníomhaíocht chultúrtha agus chruthaitheach, agus tá raidhse deiseanna bríomhara oidhreachta, ealaón agus cultúr ann ar féidir le gach duine a fhoghlaim agus bheith páirteach iontu.

Mar gheall ar bhunú an Lónra Oidhreachta agus an Lónra Ealaón le blianta beaga anuas rinneadh feasacht agus rannpháirtíocht an phobail sna healaón, i gcultúr agus san oidhreacht a chumasú agus a fhorbairt. Tá seodra ceilte de ghníomhaíocht chultúrtha aimsithe ag an dá lónra agus thíainig siad freisin ar raidhse daoine cumasacha ar fud an chontae, a bhí ag obair leo go suaimhneach i ngan fhios don phobal i gcoitinne. Éiríonn go han-mhaith le himeacht míosúil mórthaispeántais an Lónra Ealaón ó thaobh raon leathan na ndaoine cruthaitheacha atá inár bpobal a chur ar taispeáint, idir chumadoírí amhrán, filí, ealaíontóirí, staraithe áitiúla agus meáin dhigiteacha/teicneolaíocht.

Monaghan County Council's Culture Team, wish to build on these established networks and to work in conjunction with key cultural and heritage stakeholders in rolling out a diverse programme of events, which are open to everyone. The plan is to add value to established festivals such as the Carrickmacross Arts Festival, Clones Film Festival, Patrick Kavanagh Weekend whilst working with centres such as the Iontas Arts Theatre, Tyrone Guthrie Centre, Clones Arts Studio and local artists on particular projects. The establishment of a Traditional Arts Festival for young people will be a collaborative project between the cultural sector of the county council and community partners.

Alongside the programme of events, the team will be very busy researching, consulting and putting together a 5 year Creative and Cultural Plan 2018-2022 for County Monaghan. Public consultation will take place from May – August 2017 and we will use various means of consulting such as focus workshops, public surveys and networks such as PPN, Heritage, Arts, Library, and Museum.

Is mian le Foireann Chultúir Chomhairle Contae Mhuineacháin cur leis na lónraí sin atá ar an bhfód cheana agus oibriú i gcomhar le príomhpháirtithe leasmhara cultúir agus oidhreachta le clár iléagsúil imeachtaí a chur ar fáil, a bheidh ar oscailt do gach duine. Is é an pleán luach a chur le féiltí seanbhunaithe ar nós Fhéile Ealaón Charraig Mhachaíre Rois, Féile Scannán Chluain Eois, Deireadh Seachtaine Patrick Kavanagh agus oibriú le hionaid ar nós Amharclann Ealaón Iontas, Ionad Tyrone Guthrie, Stiúideo Ealaón Chluain Eois agus ealaontóirí áitiúla ar thionscadail áirithe. Bunófar Féile Ealaón Traidisiúnta do dhaoine óga mar chomhthionscadal idir earnáil chultúir na comhairle contae agus comhpháirtithe pobail.

Chomh maith leis an gelár imeachtaí, beidh an fhoireann gafa le taighde agus comhairliúchán i dtaca le Plean Cultúir 5 bliana do 2018-2022 a chur le cheile do Chontae Mhuineacháin. Beidh comhairliúchán poiblí ar siúl ó Bheatlaine - Lúnasa 2017 agus beidh muid ag úsáid modhanna éagsúla comhairliúcháin ar nós ceardlanna fócais, suirbhéanna poiblí agus lónraí ar nós an PPN agus na lónraí Oidhreachta, Ealaón, Leabharlainne agus Músaem.

The Creative Ireland Team in Monaghan

FOIREANN ÉIRE ILDÁNACH MHUINEACHÁIN

The team engaged to lead the Creative Ireland Programme in County Monaghan (the Culture Team) will be coordinated by Deirdriu McQuaid, one of 31 national coordinators who work as a national team to deliver the Creative Ireland Programme. The role of the coordinator is to bring the key county council personnel together to work together on collaborative projects under the remit of the Creative Ireland Programme, oversee the publication of a 5-year plan and implementation of key actions with all members of the steering committee having particular roles in instigating the overall plan.

The members of the Culture Team are:

Is é ról an chomhordaitheora príomhphearsana na comhairle contae a thabhairt le cheile le hoibriú as láhma a cheile ar chomhthionscadail faoi shainchúram Chlár Éire Ildánach, maoirseacht a dhéanamh ar fhoilsíú pleán 5 bliana agus príomhbhearta a chur i bhfeidhm. Beidh ról faoi leith ag gach ball den choiste stiúrtha ó thaobh an pleán foriomlán a chur ar bun. Is iad seo a leanas baill na Foirme Cultúir:

DRUM et Stedi I Irland

(October 2017)

Krass Clement, a celebrated Artist from Denmark was awarded a Danish Artist Bursary, which he used in part as an Artist in Residence at the Tyrone Guthrie centre in 1991. While there he took a series of photographs on a single evening with only a few rolls of film while conversing with the men of Drum Village over some pints of stout. It has been stated that he captured them in a unique and compelling manner. His publication containing many of these shots was published in 1996 titled DRUM et Stedi I Irland and is considered as a ground breaking publication. Artist Krass Clement will return to Monaghan in association with The Gallery of Photography, Ireland and Monaghan County Council in late Autumn 2017. There will be various strands to his visit -

- His short films will be screened in association with The Clones Film Festival. The people from Drum will be specially invited to attend to view the early work of this great Artist as part of the familiarisation of both parties to each other.
- An exhibition of the work he created as part of his book will be on display jointly between the County Library and the Courthouse in Clones
- Krass Clement will give a talk on his work and legacy of his book, which may involve giving a copy of the book (Errata Editions) to those involved from Drum.

- Déanfar a scannán ghearra a thaispeáint i gcomhar le Féile Scannán Chluain Eois. Tabharfar cuireadh speisialta do na daoine ón Droim teacht agus saothar luath an mhór-Ealaíontóir seo a fheiceáil mar bhealach leis an dá pháirtí a chur in aithne dá chéile.
- Beidh taispeántas den saothar a chruthaigh sé mar chuid dá leabhar ar taispeáint idir Leabharlann an Chontae agus Teach na Cúirte i gCluin Eois.
- Tabharfaidh Krass Clement caint maidir lena shaothar agus an méid atá fágtha le hoidhreacht lena leabhar, agus d'fhéadfadh go dtabharfaí cóip den leabhar (Errata Editions) dóibh siúd ón Droim a bhí bainteach leis.

- Krass will follow his past footsteps by staying as a guest in the Tyrone Guthrie Centre.
 - The Gallery of Photography, Ireland will be exploring a continuance or a contemporary version of what occurred back in 1991 by cataloguing and setting up family portrait sessions including the collation of existing family archival photographs from those left in the village.
- Aspects to this project may involve exploring in more detail the dereliction, vacancy and isolation created in villages like Drum in more recent times.

The Black Pigs Dyke **An Artist Impression Project**

We will commission the Artist Siobhán Mac Donald to respond to/engage with the Black Pigs Dyke, specifically with the findings and results from recent surveys. This will involve the artist engaging with an archaeologist regarding the earthworks known as the black pigs Dyke. This commissioned piece/work will be in an agreed medium, with a focus on the Black Pigs Dyke's archaeology, folklore, natural setting which will include scientific results from the past investigations. The work will aim to communicate or engage with the public about the uniqueness of these pre-historic earthworks through the dialogue and conversation initiated by the artist and her creation in her response to this project.

Crystalline: An Exhibition by Siobhan MacDonald

This exhibition arises out of Siobhan MacDonald's on-going inquiry into how humanity has become the dominant force of change on the planet. She has been working with some of the world's leading scientists at University College Dublin and the European Space Agency on this inquiry into the Arctic Circle. Her forthcoming exhibition seeks to merge the artistic and the scientific and the interconnectedness of both, highlighting how visual art can unleash the potential infinity encapsulated in a given story. An educational programme and talk series will run in conjunction with the Monaghan Science Festival. The artist is proposing a series of talks from geographers, geologists, marine researchers and architects who will explore the complexity of our current environment. The bringing together of different disciplines will provide a platform to discuss and look closely at what the future might hold. (The Market House, Monaghan, September – November 2017)

Windy Toons Traditional Arts Festival for Young Audiences

A traditional arts festival for young audiences in Co. Monaghan which will enhance traditional arts in the county through a diverse, innovative, & high quality programme for school & family audiences incorporating traditional music, song, dance, & storytelling. This festival will collaborate with local partners to create a strong festival infrastructure and will take place in various venues across the county. (Across Co. Monaghan, 24-28 October 2017)

Crystalline: Taispeántas le Siobhan MacDonald

The Italian Theatre Company

TEATRO DUE MONDI from Faenza, Italy visits Monaghan (August 2017)

Teatro Due Mondi is an independent theatre group from Faenza in Italy. The group has been doing theatre research and theatre pedagogy for over 30 years and is composed by 11 permanent members and about 12 volunteers. The artistic research of the actors/teachers is based on auto-pedagogical processes that generate shows and that stimulate diversified educational activities. Teatro Due Mondi will be visiting Monaghan during August and will link in with the Carrickmacross Arts Festival & one other partner with the following shows:

- Carosello - street theatre show with a very contemporary story about tolerance and welcoming people from abroad where the audience is directly involved. The show features the characters of The Bremen Town Musicians and transforms the traditional fairy-tale into a new and contemporary story taking place in the streets of European cities. The message of this story is told in a poetic, ironic and subtle way, allowing the spectators to think for themselves about our contemporary world and its changes: a world where it's still possible to dream and where all people come together in a big carrousel of colours.

Cuaireátabhairt ar Mhuineachán ag an

gCompántas Amharclannaíochta Iodálach, TEATRO DUE MONDI as Faenza na hlodáile (Lúnasa 2017)

Is grúpa neamhspleách amharclannaíochta as Faenza na hIodáile é Teatro Due Mondi. Tá an grúpa ag gabháil de thaighde agus oideolaíocht amharclannaíochta le breis agus 30 bliain agus cuimsíonn sé 11 chomhalta buan agus tuairim is 12 oibrethe deonacha. Tá taighde ealaíonta na n-aisteoirí/múinteoirí bunaithe ar phróisis uath-oideolaíochta lena gcruthaítear seónna agus lena spreagtar gníomhaíochtaí oideachasúla éagsúla. Beidh Teatro Due Mondi ag tabhairt cuairt ar Muineachán le linn mhí Lúnasa agus beidh siad ag nascadh le Féile Ealaón Charraig Mhachaire Rois agus compháirtí amháin eile leis na seónna seo a leanas:

- Carosello - seo amharclannaíochta sráide le scéal an-chomhaimseartha faoi chaoinfhulaingt agus fáilte a chur roimh dhaoine as áiteanna thar lear, ina mbíonn páirt dhíreach ag an lucht féachana. Cuirtear teachtaireacht an scéil in iúl ar bhealach fileata, iorónach agus caolchúiseach, lena dtugtar deis don lucht féachana a n-intinn féin a dhéanamh suas faoi dhomhan an lae inniu agus na hathruiithe atá ag teacht air: domhan inar féidir go fóill aisling a bheith agat agus ina dtagann na daoine go léir le chéile i dtimpeallán mór dathanna.

- Fiesta - street parade with the best ingredients of Italian street theatre culture: stilts, masks, rhythm and traditional singing. FIESTA is an itinerary performance which transforms streets into a festival of South-American flair. Drum rhythms, three-metre-long figures with faces of papier-mâché, colourful patched costumes, banners, whistles and fire.

Culture Night 2017

(Friday 22 September)

An evening of free events will take place throughout the county, where cultural and heritage centres will remain open late. The Monaghan Creative Team will work with local groups and organisations to present an evening of fun, interactive, family friendly events.

Japanese Themed Evening at The County Museum

To mark the 60th anniversary of diplomatic relations between Ireland and Japan the museum will present an entire programme of Japanese themed events. These will include live demonstrations of the Japanese Martial Art known as Kendo. There will also be a series of workshops focusing on Japanese traditional clothing. The ancient art of paper folding called origami will also be demonstrated through a number of interactive workshops. The highlight of the evening's festivities will be a stunning and powerful performance of the world renowned Japanese drumming known as Taiko. The entire event will provide participants with the opportunity to interact with another culture's language, tradition and beliefs in a creative, inclusive and fun way.

Hello Delia Murphy at The County Library:

Sit back and be enthralled by the songs and story of the iconic Delia Murphy sung in her own unique style. A one woman-show by her niece, Carmen Cullen and music by Gerry Anderson. Roll back the years with The Spinning Wheel and other much loved songs, and a dramatized reading as part of the show. No woman performer made a bigger impact on the Irish entertainment scene than Delia Murphy. She was a unique personality onstage and off and is credited with laying the groundwork for the Irish Folk-Revival.

Cavan Monaghan Science Festival

(12 – 19 November)

A week long programme of activities to engage all members of the public in science, technology, engineering, arts and maths with particular focus on how science and technology is hugely relevant to us all in our everyday life and to develop creativity in our children. For 2017, there will be an emphasis on supporting pillars 1 and 2 of the Creative Ireland programme, with a host of workshops on coding, using art and crafts to learn about science, and exploring biodiversity, the environment, and our heritage. The festival will have some of the best national and international scientists, artists, researchers and speakers, who will demonstrate, showcase and discuss a broad range of subjects. The week will conclude with a free Family Fun Day with workshops, demonstrations, storytelling and music.

Hello Delia Murphy @ Leabharlann an Chontae
