The Members of the Town Council thanked Phil Hogan, TD, Minister for the Environment, Community and Local Government for agreeing to meet with them following the official opening of the New Fire Station Headquarters at Annahagh, Monaghan to discuss a proposal for the former Revenue Commissioners Offices, Coolshannagh, Monaghan.

Cllr. Seán Conlon informed the Minister that correspondence was sent in April 2011 to Brian Hayes TD, Minister of State at the Department of Public Expenditure and Reform and Finance with special responsibility for Public Service Reform and the OPW and to John Perry TD, Minister of State at the Department of Enterprise, Jobs and Innovation (with special responsibility for Small Business). It was noted that the correspondence stated that the vacant former Revenue Commissioners premises would be an ideal site to be converted into affordable workspace.

Minister Phil Hogan agreed to make enquiries with Ministers Hayes and Perry regarding the proposal.
