Over 92% of people in Ireland aged 18+ are now fully vaccinated, and over 91% of people aged 12+ have received at least 1 dose.

However, COVID-19 is still spreading in our communities in Monaghan. Vaccines are proven to be your best protection against serious illness from COVID-19.

**If you haven't had your vaccine yet or you've missed your second dose, you're more at risk.**

There are now even more places available to get your free COVID-19 vaccine.

**Register online or by phone:** You can register online at [hse.ie](https://www.hse.ie) for a vaccination centre appointment if you're 16 or over. Parents of 12-15 year olds can register their children. Call HSELive on 1800 700 700 for a vaccination centre appointment.

COVID-19 is still spreading in our communities. Vaccines are proven to be your best protection against serious illness from COVID-19.

### Facts about the COVID-19 vaccine

If you haven't had your vaccine yet, or you've missed your second dose - you're more at risk of serious illness.

Everyone aged 12 or over living in Ireland can now get a free COVID-19 vaccine from the HSE.

They are also recommended for pregnant women, to protect both mother and baby.

You'll need two doses of the mRNA vaccines for the best possible protection.

You can read all about side effects and how the vaccines work on [hse.ie](https://www.hse.ie).

The vaccine is free, and you don't need a Personal Public Service Number (PPSN) to get a vaccine.

### Ways to get your vaccine

**Register online or by phone:** You can register online at [hse.ie](https://www.hse.ie) for a vaccination centre appointment if you're 16 or over. Parents of 12-15 year olds can register their children. Call HSELive on 1800 700 700 for a vaccination centre appointment.
