Findings of Lough Muckno: Road to Recovery Project

Join Monaghan County Councils Environment section along with Patrick MC Cabe from Hydrec Environmental Consulting who will present the findings from the project titled “The Lough Muckno Road to Recovery Project”.

This project involved an 18- month assessment of the inputting loads from the catchment area and a detailed lake core analysis to determine the legacy issues within the lake sediment. The project aimed to improve the understanding of the unique characteristics of Lough Muckno and to inform the development of catchment management plans.
