We require your contact details in order to communicate effectively with you as part of this relationship with you. Please note that to help protect your privacy, we take steps to verify your identity before granting access to personal data. These contact details may also be used to verify your identify.

Lawfulness of processing

• To comply with our legal obligations and in the exercise of official authority vested in us as the controller under the Road Traffic Act 1920, Road Traffic Acts 1961-2016 and Monaghan County Council Parking Control (Pay Parking) Bye-Laws 2014 and Article 6 (1)(e) GDPR

Who does the Council share your information with?

The Council may, in the exercise of official authority vested in us as the controller, share your personal data with the selected third parties, including for example Law Agents, Globetech where required to do so by law.

What will happen if the personal data requested is not provided?

If the application form is not completed in full and all the requested information provided, the council will not be able to process your Appeal.
